

From February 2002, through December 2020, my husband was an attorney with the Davis Brown Law Firm. In 2021, the firm began its affiliation with Dentons, such that my husband was not employed by Dentons Davis Brown as it is currently structured. I know several of the attorneys at Dentons Davis Brown; I have had matters with Dentons Davis Brown attorneys both as co-counsel and as opposing counsel. I do not presently have any pending matters involving Dentons Davis Brown counsel. I know Tara Hall as an attorney with my husband's former firm.

Also, Ms. Hall and I are both members of C. Edwin Moore Inn of Court, an inn of court for central Iowa attorneys. From September through May, the Inn holds monthly dinner meetings. A different group of attorneys is responsible for arranging the continuing education presentation for each month. For the October 2022 presentation, Ms. Hall and I are in the same presentation group. Ms. Hall and I have exchanged emails regarding the preparation for the October continuing education presentation.

I am also a past President of the Inn, although I am not certain whether Ms. Hall was a member of the Inn for the period that I presided over the monthly meetings as President.

From April 2021 through September 2021, my firm represented an individual in a breach of contract dispute against Paypal. The matter settled before any lawsuit was filed. Paypal was represented by counsel in that matter, but Paypal was not represented by either Dentons Davis Brown or by Snell & Wilmer (whose name appears on the demand).

I have a personal Paypal account, which I use approximately one time per month or less.
